EBII Group Corp. Launches the Inaugural African Leaders and Partners Summit in Washington, DC.


Building on the momentum of the African Leaders and Partners (ALP) Forum held during the World Bank/IMF April 2025 Spring Meetings, EBII Group is proud to announce the rebranding of its flagship summit. **The African Leaders and Partners Summit (ALP Summit) will replace the Africa Investment Risk and Compliance Summit (AIRCS), marking a new chapter in our journey.**

While AIRCS has been instrumental in convening heads of state, regulators, and private sector leaders to tackle issues around financial integrity and governance, the ALP Summit expands this vision. It will bring together a broader coalition—including high-level government officials, global investors, and multilateral institutions—to explore trade, investment, food security, and energy transition through the lens of risk mitigation and long-term resilience.

The theme for this inaugural gathering is:

"Advancing U.S. and Ğlobal Investment in Africa's Food and Energy Future: A Strategic Approach to Risk Mitigation and Mutual Prosperity."

The ALP Summit reflects EBII Group's core mission: bridging Africa with the global community through trusted risk and compliance insight. Over the years, the Summit has drawn high-caliber leaders, including the Presidents of Ghana and Sierra Leone, the Prime Minister of St. Lucia, the AfCFTA Secretary-General, U.S. Congressional leaders, central bank governors, global CEOs, and the Vice-Chancellor of Oxford University.

- BADEA's strategic vision: Aligning Arab-African partnerships to support sustainable investment and economic development
